Workshop Description: Learn how to paint in watercolour and be inspired by a variety of subjects and techniques. In each workshop we will paint a particular subject, working from a choice of images. Images are provided but you can bring your own if you wish. Your tutor Trudi will offer demonstrations and help along the way.

The examples shown below have been created by previous A.L.C.S clients.

Week 1: Introduction to the art materials, create a colour chart and practise colour mixing. Draw and paint a fish.



Week 2: Skies and silhouettes: Paint watercolour skies using wet in wet technique, using salt and add a simple silhouette.



Week 3: Birds: Paint birds and add a background.



Week 4: Spring plants: Explore different plants, colours and textures.



Week 5: Butterflies: Create a symmetrical image of an enlarged butterfly.



Week 6: Boats on water explore contour, composition and reflection.
